A Capacity Building Event for Young Scientists

A-Concept and Purpose

The **4th ANSOLE National Conference in Cameroon (ANSOLECAM 2017)** will take place from the 18th to the 19th of December 2017 at the Faculty of Technology and Engineering (FET) of the University of Buea. The event is a multidisciplinary forum of exchange among various stakeholders in the field of sustainable energetics in Cameroon. It is jointly organized by the University of Buea and the Ecole Nationale Supérieure des Travaux Publics (National Advanced School of Public Works) of Yaounde.

The first day of the event will be marked by the signing of a MoU between the University of Buea and ANSOLE at the opening ceremony, followed by oral and poster presentations as well as visit of experimental laboratories at FET. The second day consists of lectures in the morning period followed by ANSOLE general assembly in Cameroon to discuss issue pertaining to (1) restructuring of the network within the country, (2) organization of practical training and consultancies in Cameroon, (3) implementation of Masters study programmes on renewable energies at key institutions in Cameroon and (4) collaboration in training and research among the institutions, etc. This will necessitate the participation of all ANSOLE members in the country and beyond.

The participation of international guests, especially those seeking collaboration with Cameroonian scientists, is highly appreciated. We invite Cameroonians living abroad to participate to the event before spending end of year festivities with relatives in Cameroon...

An abstract (in English) should not exceed one page. It is made up of a title, names of authors (name of presenting author underlined), affiliation of authors, email addresses of presenting and corresponding authors, abstract main text, keywords, acknowledgements (if any) and references. It should be written in Arial font 12.

Posters should be in a portrait format and appropriate format dimension should be 84x119 cm (A0 size).
